In **2001**, GSCF completely rebuilt the original structure, which provided **Classroom #1** (15' x 20').

In **2004**, the school had almost 40 pupils and was bursting at the seams. We spent one week working and completed a 25' x 25' **Open Air Pavilion**, while studying the site for the best location for the much needed 2nd Classroom.

In 2005, we built the following structures:

Classroom # 2 (20' x 25') **A Kitchen (10' x 10')** **Toilets (25' x 12')**

All buildings have concrete roofs and with the gutter systems we installed, we keep the 8 x 1,000 gallons holding tanks full of water. The toilets are "waterless", are odour-free and easy to clean. Stainless steel appliances were installed in the kitchen.

By the summer of 2007, the school enrollment had expanded to over 90 pupils. Also, with the Basic School covering 3 years of education, it made sense to build a 3rd classroom.

In 2008, we finished a 2-story building. **Classroom #3** is located at the upper ground level. On the lower level, there are **2 Storage Areas**, a **Tuck Shop** and **1 Teachers' Office**. There are three sinks installed so that the building is better suited to accommodate the visiting medical staff when they visit the village.
